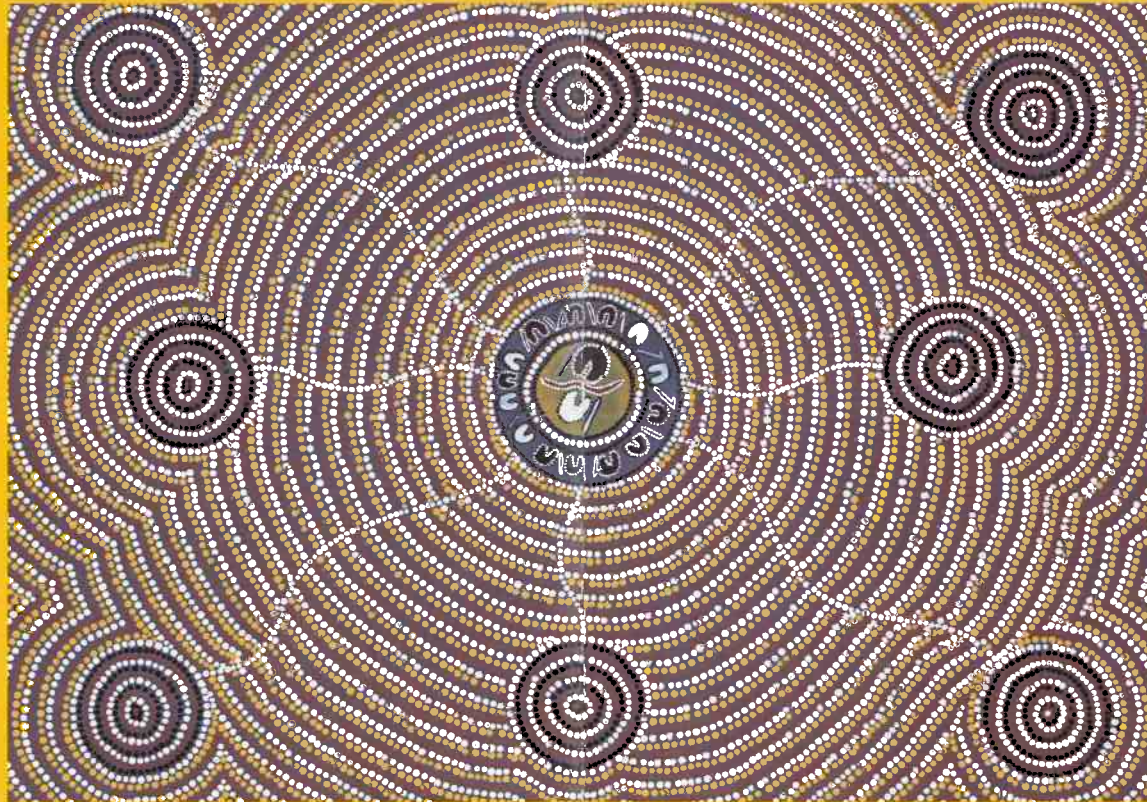

The white dots leading from the communities to the Commonwealth Carelink Centre in the middle of the painting represent tracks.

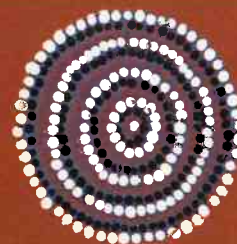

When you ring the national free telephone number 1800 052 222*, you will be talking to your nearest Centre. Someone who will know your area will answer your call. You can get information over the phone or by mail.

Anyone can use a Commonwealth Carelink Centre to get free information.

These centres can provide information about:

- who to ring and how to ring for services
- who is to receive services, and
- if any money is to be paid when you receive services.

Aged Care Assessment Teams can help you get a Community Aged Care Package or entry to aged care homes.
