# Chocolate Zucchini Cake

To celebrate World Chocolate Day in July, we share Support Worker Graeme Smith's delicious chocolate cake recipe.

#### **Ingredients**

½ cup (130g) butter 1½ cups (350g) sugar 2 eggs

2 eggs
1 tsp vanilla essence
½ cup milk or plain yoghurt
2½ cups (360g) plain flour
50g cacao powder
½ tsp ground cinnamon
½ tsp salt
1 tsp bicarbonate of soda

1 tsp baking powder 2 cups (250g) zucchini, shredded 250g chopped nuts, optional (pecans, walnuts or macadamias)

#### Method

- 1. Cream butter and sugar then beat in the eggs.
- 2. Fold in milk/yoghurt and vanilla.
- 3. Add sifted dry ingredients.
- 4. Stir in zucchini.
- 5. Pour into a 23 cm x 30 cm pan lined with baking paper.
- 6. Bake at 160°C for 50-60 minutes.
